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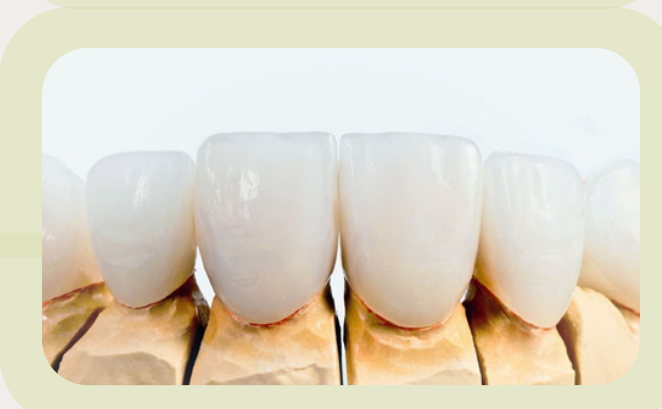


# THE PROCESS INVOLVED

On the first visit, a tiny portion of the tooth surface, typically less than a millimetre is removed to make room for the veneers. After reshaping the teeth, an impression is taken and will be used to customise your veneers.



On your next visit, your dentist will try the veneers on the tooth to check fit and colour and will make adjustments if necessary. Once everything is perfect, the veneers are bonded onto the teeth. This appointment may take a couple of hours.



The veneers are then crafted in a dental laboratory to match the colour, size and shape of your natural teeth. While you wait for your veneers to be ready, your dentist will provide you with temporary veneers.



*You may experience some sensitivity to hot and cold drinks for a few days. This is normal and will subside within a few days. You may also notice that your bite feels different. This is because your veneers are slightly thicker than your natural teeth. You will get used to your new veneers within a few days. If you have any questions or concern, please contact our office. # UNDERSTANDING COMPOSITE VENEERS



Composite veneers are made from a tooth--coloured resin material that is applied directly to your teeth and shaped into place in the dentist office. This procedure can usually be completed in a single visit as they will be manufactured in-house without the need of a laboratory.

They are hardened with a special light and polished to create a smooth, well polished surface. They are indeed a cost effective and easily repairable option to enhance your smile.



Composite veneers may not last as long as porcelain veneers. 5 to 10 years with proper care. They are cheaper than porcelain veneers and can be repaired or modified if needed. However, they won't match your natural tooth as porcelain veneers do and they are prone to stains and discoloration.

# CARING FOR YOUR DENTAL VENEERS

- Veneers, like natural teeth need regular cleaning to stay in good condition.
- Brush your teeth twice a day and floss daily. This helps prevent gum disease and decay of the natural teeth supporting your veneers.
- Regular professional cleans are crucial to remove tartar and keep your gums healthy. On your routine dental check up, your dentist will examine your veneers and overall oral health.
- Avoid biting down on hard foods with your veneers to prevent fracture or chipping. Porcelain veneers are strong and durable. As with your natural teeth, biting and chewing on non food objects or ice will always increase the risk of chipping your veneers. With proper care, your veneers will stay beautiful for years to come.
- Try to limit foods that can stain your teeth like coffee, tea, red wine and tobacco. Porcelain veneers resist stains but the resin cement used to bond them may discolour over time.
- Wear a mouth guard if you play contact sports or grind your teeth at night. Wearing a custom mouth guard will help protect your veneers
- Treat veneers like natural teeth and look after them as much as you look after your natural teeth.
- By following these simple steps, you can ensure that your dental veneers will last many years.



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
